Please Note: The calendar month in which the cylinder is sold is counted as month 1 of the free loan period.

For Example: If a cylinder is purchased on 13th March 2013 – the period from 13th March 2013 until 31st March 2013 would count as month **1**.

All cylinders get either a 3 or 6 month free loan period depending on the type of cylinder purchased. Cylinders with a 6 month free loan period are then given until the **end** of month **7** and cylinders with a 3 month free loan period are given until the **end** of month **4** to be returned. After this a monthly rental charge will be incurred.

*** Reclaim and Receiver Cylinders**

If a Reclaim or Receiver cylinder is outstanding at the **end** of month **7**, the cylinder will be classified as "LOST" and the relevant lost cylinder charge will be applied.

RECOVERY CYLINDERS: MAXIMUM FILL WEIGHTS

Health and Safety is of paramount importance, and the maximum fill weights on our recovery cylinders are there to prevent dangerous situations, such as manual handling related injuries and cylinder rupture from occurring.

The maximum fill weights on our recovery cylinders are:

Small	10KG
Large	45KG

This Information is stencilled on the body of the cylinder and detailed on the sticker on the cylinder shroud:



It is the service engineer's responsibility to ensure that:

Recovery Cylinders are not overfilled
The correct fill weight is declared on the Hazardous Waste Consignment Paperwork upon return of the cylinder to the branch.

Overfilling cylinders by any amount is unacceptable and under no circumstances should recovery cylinders be filled above the maximum fill weight labelled on the cylinder.

As of 1st April 2013 FSW will now issue a charge per kilo for any overfilled cylinders.

The cost for overfilling is £15.00 per kilo.

For example: If a small 10KG recovery cylinder is returned to us and weighs 12KG you will receive a charge for £30.00 plus vat for overfilling.

Overfilling of cylinders is a serious Health & Safety issue, which is taken very seriously by the Health & Safety Executive.

We will have no alternative but inform the Health & Safety Executive of persistent offenders, which could result in a fine or further action being taken.
